

# **AURELIUS TOWNSHIP BOARD**

## **May 8, 2007**

The Aurelius Township Board met in regular session on Tuesday, May 8, 2007, at the Aurelius Township Hall, 1939 S. Aurelius Road, Mason, Michigan. Board members present: Clark, Droscha, Johnson, and Silsby. Absent: None. Also Present: Lawrence Hawkins, Shelly Heaviland and Gary Raymond.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Silsby at 7:30 p.m. All joined in the pledge to the United States flag.

### **CONSENT AGENDA:**

CORRESPONDENCE was reviewed.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

INGHAM COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION 2007 Local Road Improvement Program has been reinstated for Townships. The Ingham County Road Commission has approved the Township's request for carry over of our unused 2006 matching funds in the amount of \$22,200.00. This gives Aurelius Township a total of \$44,400.00 for road improvements this year; or a grand total, including Road Commission's match, of \$88,800.00 for 2007 road projects. A request to carry over 2004 and 2005 unused matching funds was denied.

SPEED BUMPS for the driveway at the Township Hall and Glenna Droscha Park have been ordered. This should help slow the traffic when there is a lot of evening activity at the Park and Hall.

IMPROVMENTS TO THE GREENWOOD CEMETERY driveways are necessary. Tomco Asphalt will be making the improvements before Memorial Day week end.

SUPERVISOR reviewed a complaint from JR & DeLynn Dart concerning activities at his neighbors. The letter has been forwarded to the Township Attorney for his review.

CLERK reported the School Election was currently taking place.

TREASURER report of balances in accounts was reviewed.
